PREVENTION MEASURES

PERSONAL SAFETY

Wearing of gloves, safety glasses and appropriate clothing to prevent skin contact when using the product is always recommended.

NEIGHBORING AREA PROTECTION

Always protect the neighboring working area against unexpected contact with the product to avoid irreversible damage or alterations that could only be restored by its replacement

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS

Surface temperature should be between 15 and 30°C (59 and 86°F).

Ideal temperature for best results.

Test first on a small and adequate surface, to assess results.

- First time user, without preliminary testing.

Never use the product for the first time on a large area without preliminary testing.

Usage of the product on an alkaline sensitive material could alter irreversibly the covering material that would only be restored by its replacement.

<p><u>- Using the product on a new surface or on an unknown surface, without preliminary testing.</u></p> <p>Even if you have used the product in the past, because covering manufacturers do modify occasionally the composition of their products, there could be, without your knowledge, presence of an incompatible substance that could be irreversibly damaged or altered or give unexpected end results that would only be restored by its replacement.</p> <p>More so, even if the product is lightly alkaline, it could damage the finish or the protection of certain materials. Some acrylics (bathtubs, showers, sinks) are sensitive to alkaline cleaning products when used with the scrubbing action of nylon scuff pads.</p> <p>Finally, since 2016 we note that some polished Quartz products, Quartzite surfaces and flamed granites are very sensitive to alkaline products. Application of a wax or an acrylic finish by the manufacturers seems to be at the origin of the problem.</p> <p>METHOD OF APPLICATION</p> <p><u>Cleaning floors using the Ready to Use formula in a spray gun bottle a telescopic mop and a microfiber cloth:</u></p> <p>Spray directly on a damp Microfiber Cloth and wipe the floor.</p> <p>To refill the 700ml spray gun bottle, pour the 100ml recharge and complete with tap water.</p> <p><u>Cleaning counters with Ready to Use formula in a spray gun bottle:</u></p> <p>Spray directly on the surface to clean and wipe with a clean dry or damp cloth or a paper towel.</p> <p>For stubborn stains, let the cleaning solution work 1 to 2 minutes, scrub and wipe. Use concentrated if needed.</p> <p><u>Cleaning using the concentrated formula with a bucket and mop:</u></p> <p>Mix 125 ml (4 oz) of concentrated cleaner with 2 to 4 litres (½ to 1 gallon) of warm water. Wring well the mop before cleaning the surface.</p> <p>For stubborn stains, let the solution work 1 to 2 minutes, scrub and wipe.
